

# HB 2028/SB 1189 Supplemental Reductions; Appropriations 2008-2009 First Regular Session 2009

Signed by Gov. Brewer on 5/14/2009

**Summary of Legislation:** This legislation delayed \$100 million in FY 2008-09 university payments into the next budget year. It reduces K-12 public education funding for FY 2008-09 by \$300 million. This reduction does NOT apply to charter schools and very small school districts. NOTE: This is a *current year budget reduction* that was signed in the *last month* of the school year – after the money originally budgeted to the schools had likely already been spent/committed.

## Vote Translation:

“YES” on bill = Vote to reduce funding for the in-progress school year’s K-12 education budget.

“NO on bill = Vote to maintain in-progress school year’s budget.
