

# SB 1001/HB 2001: Budget Reductions and Transfers; 2008-2009 First Special Session 2009

Signed by Gov. Brewer on 1/31/09

**Summary of Legislation:** This legislation calls for the reduction in the K-12 FY 2008-2009 budget of \$133 million; a reduction to community colleges of \$9 million; a reduction to university funding of \$141.5 million. It also reduces the appropriation made to the Arizona Twenty-First Century Competitive Initiative Fund by \$22.5 million dollars.

## Vote Translation:

“YES” on bill = Vote for large cuts to the FY 2008-2009 K-12 and higher education budgets.

“NO on bill = Vote to maintain previously approved FY 2008-2009 K-12 and higher education funding.
